Description I just tried running blender today and it gives the error "blender: error while loading shared libraries: libGLEW.so.1.13: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory". The only major thing I've done is update with "pacman -Syu". Blender was working in the last couple of days. The glew package available is 2.0.0-1 and pkgfile says it gives "/usr/lib/libGLEW.so.1.13" however running "pacman -Qi" gives "/usr/lib/libGLEW.so.2.0" instead.
