After todays system upgrade I get the following error message when trying to visit websites such as en.wikipedia.org or www.google.com using iceweasel:

Your connection is not secure

The website tried to negotiate an inadequate level of security.

en.wikipedia.org uses security technology that is outdated and vulnerable to attack. An attacker c ould easily reveal information which you thought to be safe. The website administrator will need t o fix the server first before you can visit the site.

Error code: NS_ERROR_NET_INADEQUATE_SECURITY

I guess this has something to do with recent updates of nss and ca-certificates-mozilla while iceweasel is still not updated to v. 51. The issue can be reproduced on the official parabola-mate live image after the system update using pacman -Syu
