<b>Description</b> PyQt5's configure script checks if it can build a simple program linked against each of the Qt modules that it supports, and (silently!) disables any modules that fail this test.  Because of issue <a href="#">#1271</a> , libGL.so is broken, which most of Qt links against, so almost everything gets disabled.  What good is PyQt5 without the QtGui module!?
