<b>Description</b> Hi everybody, since kdepim-runtime is built without nonfree qt5-webengine, every KDE application needing libQt5WebEngine* won't work anymore. For example, <b>Kaddressbook</b> , <b>Korganizer</b> , <b>Kontact</b> and <b>Kmail</b> all return the following error: error while loading shared libraries: libQt5WebEngineWidgets.so.5: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory  These packages (I didn't identify all of them) should be removed from repositories, by the time we find a replacement for qt5-webengine, shouldn't they ?
