since kdepim-runtime is built without nonfree qt5-webengine, every KDE application needing libQt5WebEngine* won't work anymore. For example, **Kaddressbook**, **Korganizer**, **Kontact** and **Kmail** all return the following error:

error while loading shared libraries: libQt5WebEngineWidgets.so.5: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory

These packages (I didn't identify all of them) should be removed from repositories, by the time we find a replacement for qt5-webengine, shouldn't they?
