1.2.1.2. Usage Rights: Developer may install and use multiple copies of the Materials on a shared computer or concurrently on different computers, and make multiple back-up copies of the Materials, **solely for Licensee's use within Licensee's Enterprise**. "Enterprise" shall mean individual use by Licensee or any legal entity (such as a corporation or university) and the subsidiaries it owns by more than 50 percent.

1.2.1.3. Further Redistribution Rights: ... **Licensee may authorize** Customers to further redistribute the Redistributable SOFTWARE that such Customers receive as part of the Licensee Application, **solely in binary form** ...
