<p>I no longer believe that nshd should be a daemon. I believe that it should be implemented as an nss module and as a pam module.</p> <p>As much as I love Go, I don't believe that we should have to load the Go runtime into essentially every process; so writing the modules in Go is out. Maybe rust, but probably C.</p> <p>OTOH, perhaps a standard SQL nss/pam module would be the way to go, and have it load the data into SQL.</p> <p>I'm liking the idea of using SQL as an ACID cache for things for which the authoritative source is in git.</p>
