Most of this actually belongs to the server-side sibling of libretools: dbscripts.

But the cgroup thing is... not. Are you running notsystemd or systemd? ~~Are you on OpenRC?~~ (edit: of course you're not on OpenRC, those are systemd cgroup paths). If you're using libre/systemd, this should be sent upstream to systemd (if it hasn't been reported there already). If you're running libre/notsystemd... hold on for v234.2 ("any day now™").
