please be more detailed, this issue lacks of important info like:

- **Init system:** OpenRC, right? I deduce this due to the error message
- **ISO used:** I cannot guess it
- **The way you installed the system:** cannot deduce it either, but I'm sure you didn't used the LXDE OpenRC install scripts, because those do not have that issue
- **Post installation or LiveCD system?** in which case it was post-installation this should not be in "Installation Media" since its a problem of dbus in OpenRC **on the installed system**, not the ISO live system itself
- **dbus package:** dbus or dbus-elogind?

to solve the dbus issue, do:

```
1. pacman -S dbus-elogind # groupadd -r -g 81 # useradd -r -u 81 -g 81 -s /sbin/nologin dbus # rc-service dbus start
```

and you are done. We must fix the post-install hook in dbus-elogind, due to this, I'll assign this issue to ovruni meanwhile
