<p>I'm running the latest [nonprism] version of Icedove (1:52.6.0-2.nonprism1), and when connecting to IRC it ends into a Segfault (don't know if it happens with the rest of the nets like XMPP and the PRISM ones):</p> <pre>\$ icedove [calBackendLoader] Using Thunderbird's builtin libical backend Segmentation fault</pre>	
<p>However this happens on the [libre] version too, right when the account connects. Recompiling might fix this (I've not tried that, however).</p>
