<p>Every now and then, when I right click on the menu bar in LXDE the menu either crashes and starts again (blinks) or completely crashes.</p> <p>For some reason the more it crashes within a single session, the faster it starts crashing when I restart it. in the worse case you would need to run lxpanel under gdb and try to make it crash to get a better backtrace
