Hi,	
As I understand, linux-libre-pae is the only way to get the following features on 32bit installations:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• More than 4GB of RAM if the chipset supports it</li><li>• NX bit (security features that can set data to be non-executables in RAM)</li></ul>	
However when trying to install it we have a conflict:	
<pre># pacman -S linux-libre-pae resolving dependencies... looking for conflicting packages... :: linux-libre-pae and your-freedom are in conflict (linux-pae). Remove your-freedom? [y/N]</pre>
