Recently tried to build a PKGBUILD (iceweasel-hardened-preferences) with whirlpoolsums in it.			
libremakepkg threw the following error:			
<pre>==> Starting pre-build activities... ==> Downloading blacklist of proprietary software packages...done -> Inspecting package pkgname=iceweasel-hardened-preferences (1.0-2) ==> Downloading sources... ==> ERROR: Cannot find the whirlpoolsum binary required for source file checksums operations. ==> ERROR: Could not download sources.</pre>			
pacman -Fo whirlpoolsum returns no results sym linking /usr/bin/whirlpoolsum -> rhash --whirlpool (in the chroot) did not help as it is clearly looking to download a package containing whirlpoolsum			
removing those sums from the PKGBUILD (they seem to be some sort of duplicate or backup sums) Cleared the error and allowed the build to go ahead
