Don't uninstall systemd-libsystemd. If you install it, emacs should work again.

Don't use pacman -Rdd commands (which you presumably used to remove it) unless you **really** know what you're doing. (It was foolish of the author of the OpenRC article to recommend that; I've removed that section.)

Pacman's -dd should be renamed to --ignore-all-dependencies-even-though-it-might-break-my-system.
