Description It is possible to insert some coinbase data, like Satoshi Nakamoto did. He included the following string in the source code: const char* pszTimestamp = "The Times 03/Jan/2009 Chancellor on brink of second bailout for banks"; There were some reports that child pornography was included in blockchain. It is also possible to include some illegal number in it, like AACs encryption key, and Bitcoin Core will download it without asking user. This is applicable to any/most cryptocurrencies. Please, delete them from Parabola repositories.

if you can show that this program or the others are non-free or illegal in some way, or at least give us some small indication of how anyone could begin to research and prove any of the things you claim, that would be worth following up on - but with only the tiny bits of very uninformative information you supplied, there is still nothing that can be done with this report (and the others) other than to close them due to lack of information
