Hello,	
I did a full system reinstall (pacman -Qnq pacman -S -) and when I booted, I could not use the mouse, touchpad nor keyboard. These worked well in the local virtual terminal (tty), but as soon as I started X (startx), they would stop working. I rebooted with 4.19.29-gnu-1-lts, and I could log-in. This also happened with a windows manager (lightdm), where the user dialog would show up, but I could not type nor move the cursor.
