openrc is a bit tricky to install with an automated script just now - you would need to run a few commands first

```
cd /root/.scriptsInstallation/  
sed -i 's|archlinux)|archlinux archlinux32|' ./install.sh  
sed -i 's|base-openrc|base-openrc systemd-libs-dummy systemd-dummy|' ./install.sh
```

then you should be able to run the install script successfully
