Description evince for i686 is on an older version (3.30.2-1.0), which expects to use libsyntax.so.1. however, current versions of libre/libsyntax only provide libsyntax.so.2. the program won't even start without libsyntax.so.1

libsyntax is part of the texlive-bin package.
that was rebuilt on 06-25-2019 , It mostlikely broke evince at that point
As there is a poppler update in the pipes on i686 texlive-bin and libsyntax (split package)
will have to be rebuilt at that time.

I'll keep an eye on this. If it is still an issue after the new poppler we may have to special case i686's texlive-bin build to be a version or two behind

for now you can:

```
sudo ln -s /usr/lib/libsyntax.so.2 /usr/lib/libsyntax.so.1
```

that will allow evince to work for the time being
