i experienced this problem when i was installing the net install openrc cli on my computer, following the installation guide from our wiki i told about this problem on the irc chat with bill-auger and freemor, and after much inquiring we realized that my linux-libre.preset was empty, and i typed the linux-libre.preset that freemor provided me, and that fixed the problem

all i can say is that somehow, even after reinstalling linux-libre kernel, the system didn't provide a preset for mkinit before it was fixed.

i wish i could provide more information about this, and i'm sorry i can't be more specific, because i'm using systemd until openrc eventually becomes stable and this problem only happened this one time

i installed openrc two more times after that and i didn't come across this bug again, so it's better not to be concerned about this problem at the moment
