Description Recently strange issue appeared with reboot or shutdown on my computer. I'm using account created by systemd complete iso graphical installer. When I attempt to reboot or shutdown, it freezes for some time without any output. This issue is not present if I log off before doing this. Most likely timeout is reached and something is killed.

I've seen systemd do something similar in many different cases - it is usually waiting for some service to shutdown - on the screen you may see a count-down timer like "waiting for stop job ..."
