<b>Description</b> Just updated Iceweasel to the latest version, which is just a rebuild against latest icu, but for some reason Jitsi Meet (just tested the official meet.jit.si instance) simply doesn't work, I cannot listen nor see other users. Reverting to 1:75.0-1.parabola2 solves the problem (I've installed icu65 from the AUR, so it works)
