This still needs rebuilding against protobuf >= 3.15.6. The problem is the existing PKGBUILD fails to build, presumably due to some updated dependency that was fixed upstream in Clementine.

In case it helps, I've updated the nonfree-artwork patch to work with the 1.4.0rc1+495+g10bf5dc17 version used in Arch, which builds fine on my end: <http://ix.io/3hJU>
