Description I tried to install packages cups and cups-pdf. The dependency cups-filters could not be installed: error: cups-filters: signature from "Andreas Grapentin <andreas@grapentin.org>" is unknown trust :: File /var/cache/pacman/pkg/cups-filters-1.27.5-1.parabola2-x86_64.pkg.tar.xz is corrupted (invalid or corrupted package (PGP signature)). Do you want to delete it? [Y/n] error: failed to commit transaction (invalid or corrupted package (PGP signature)) I refreshed both the whole keyring and the particular key from that maintainer following step 1 in the Wiki to no avail.

```

I'm having a similar situation with tokyocabinet (from libretools). I keep getting

```
pacman-key --refresh-keys andreas@grapentin.org
gpg: refreshing 1 key from hkps://hkps.pool.sks-keyservers.net
gpg: keyserver refresh failed: Operation not permitted
==> ERROR: A specified local key could not be updated from a keyserver.
```

I also tried with

```
sudo pacman-key -a /tmp/key
```

(key is attached).
