## **Description**

I just did a fresh install. I selected the dvorak keyboard layout during installation. I discovered that whenever I open a terminal, it changes the layout to qwerty for the entire window session. This seems to be caused by the default .bashrc, whose last line is 'setxkbmap us'. (I haven't rebooted to test yet, but the diagnosis looks pretty obvious.) As far as I know, there would be no downside to simply removing that line.
