<b>Description</b> openrc cant start hostname  <code>/etc/init.d/hostname: line 36: hostname: command not found</code>  Bluez needs a running hostname-service. To start the hostname-service inetutils (hostname-comand) is required. By defauid openrc tries to start hostname-service and throws a warning. I would also add Inetutils as a opt-dependency to openrc.
