Hi Not sure if an update to UWSGI or another dependency has broken searx. But it reports internal server error and no displays the searx search page etc. Checking the systemd logs, appears to show that the app searx is unknown. Not sure if this the newest version at <a href="https://github.com/searx/searx/releases">https://github.com/searx/searx/releases</a> would fix this? it had another release on 14th December 2020	
Steps to reproduce. Keep System up to date, running searx. Try navigating to local host or host address where searx is. Internal server error displayed.
