I'd rather not remove all downloaded packages, as the issue does not seem to be related to a specific package.

The issue does not only occur with dovecot, but with libzen as well.

When performing a manual upgrade of the same package pacman complains about, it works.

I agree that the issue appears to be related to the ?noredirect suffix, which I presume is added by the mirror. I use the standard (system-defined) revolving mirror on all my systems, btw.

Same for dovecot, the actual downloaded file is ok, but something trips up pacman during "pacman -Syyu" into thinking there is corruption/too-large-file issue.

I'm pretty sure this is related to the redirector service, as repository sync is sometimes painfully slow. (and no, there is no issue with the Internet connection)

Yep, just forgot to mark it as such. Confirmed but hard to catch.

The timing out part definitely seems to be about trying to -Suuy while winston is rsync'ing from Arch. For some reason that is causing a more noticable lagginess than it used to.

The wrong size. Seems to be some weird edge case. I'll try tonight to see if it happens if one -Suys just prior to the Rsync with arch (because that is when it happened last night). From the debug log it looks like it might be a case of pacman, gpgme, or curl getting confused by the 304 response from the redirector and sticking the ?noredirect parameter between the basenane and the .sig extension

So it's down to which part of the process is sticking the ?noredirect in the wrong spot.

Redmine does not supply the timezone or UTC time, which would make this easier to pinpoint.

For the instance reported earlier on June 24th: (libzen)

If anything special happened on your server-end during that time it could give some clues. But it does sound like this is caused by a bottleneck which would be addressed by some load-sharing and dedicated systems. Nevertheless strange that nginx would put these suffices on the packages due to this.

There are no packages that this has consistently happened with hours or days after it started. I can re-test from one of the systems if this happens again. On the main server the packages affected were simply upgraded manually from /var/cache/pacman/pkg

It is correct that I mentioned a server busy error many posts back, and I sincerely apologize if this offended you in some way. It was mentioned as these issues appeared to be capacity-related, which they now have been confirmed as being.
