it appears to support gopher also, so this will be a nice addition - we added a gopher server a few months ago

it appears that some of the required, dependencies were not actually used - according to the README, the AUR PKGBUILD compiles the vendored harfbuz and fridibi; so it does not actually depend on those packages in the depends array - we prefer to use system libs whenever possible; so i deleted the vendored libs and configured it to use the system libs
