I am not sure, but it sounds like the same or similar issue in <https://labs.parabola.nu/issues/2706>. I was using the version in pcr but its sounds like the same issue, I think I ended up changing the java path in usr/bin/jitsi as time4tea said in their post, it seems it is set as `JAVABIN="/usr/lib/jvm/java-8-openjdk/bin/java"` when it needs to be `JAVABIN="/usr/lib/jvm/java-8-openjdk/jre/bin/java"`.
