<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• steps to reproduce:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) # pacman -Syu</li><li>2) Allow glib2 upgrade 2.68.4-1 =&gt; 2.70.0-1</li><li>3) \$ evolution</li></ol></li><li>• expected result:<p>I expect evolution to open and access the account login secrets stored in the gnome-keyring "login" key ring.</p></li><li>• actual result:<p>Instead, evolution fails to connect to and access the key ring, and is therefore unable to access the stored accounts. It can't even see the key ring.</p></li><li>• second example<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>3) \$ seahorse</li></ol></li><li>• expected result:<p>I expect seahorse to display the "Passwords" category populated with key rings.</p></li><li>• actual result:<p>No "Password" category is displayed and no key rings are listed. Confirmed that key ring files do exist.</p></li><li>• temporary fix Downgrading glib2 2.70.0-1 =&gt; 2.68.4-1 fixes the problem. evolution and seahorse work as expected.</li></ul>
