It can't even see the key ring.</p>• second example<ol style="list-style-type: none">3) \$ seahorse• expected result:<p>I expect seahorse to display the "Passwords" category populated with key rings.</p>• actual result:<p>No "Password" category is displayed and no key rings are listed. Confirmed that key ring files do exist.</p>• temporary fix Downgrading glib2 2.70.0-1 => 2.68.4-1 fixes the problem. evolution and seahorse work as expected.
