| <p>This package is already in the AUR, is popular, and appears to be libre.</p> <p>It is a fork of Audacity after the relatively recent hostile takeover and series of fiascos, including adding spyware to Audacity and potentially violating the GNU GPL.</p> <p>I think due to these reasons that it's also likely to replace audacity in the official Arch repos at some point.</p> <p>(The version of audacity in the repos at the moment is currently unaffected by these issues, but might be once the package is updated, if that ever happens instead of it being replaced by tenacity.)</p> | | | |

Audacity 3.2 has a "Get more effects..." button in an effects sidebar that links to the Audacity online manual, which itself links to plugins, some of which are nonfree.

There is also a "Share Audio" button on the top bar that links to the <https://audio.com> service; I have no idea whether this service is SaaS or raises other freedom or privacy concerns.
