<p>When trying to update the system, I get a package conflict error. Now I have package "python-mistune1 0.8.4-4" as dependence of "pcbdraw 0.6.1-3" package. Pacman want install new package "python-mistune 2.0.4-1" as dependence "jupyter-nbconvert 7.0.0-2" as dependence "spyder 5.3.2-2". These packages conflict among themselves.</p>

ok so that conflict is going to remain for a while - it will not be possible to keep both 'spyder' and 'pcbdraw' installed at the same time, until the 'pcbdraw' developers can resolve this BR <https://github.com/yaqwsx/PcbDraw/issues/103> - 'pcbdraw' is requiring a much older version of 'python-mistune'; and is in danger of being dropped from arch because of that, because all other dependents of 'python-mistune' have moved forward

if you must keep both installed, just do not upgrade the system until the problem is resolved - if you are a programmer, maybe you could help the 'pcbdraw' developers to become compatible with the newer 'python-mistune'
