<ul style="list-style-type: none">steps to reproduce:<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) open https://www.parabola.nu/packages/?sort=-last_update&arch=x86_64&q=&maintainer=&flagged=2) compare with https://archlinux.org/packages/?sort=-last_update3) Remove all servers except the following from /etc/pacman.d/mirrorlist to keep only the main repo and exclude all the mirrors Server = https://repo.parabola.nu/\$repo/os/\$arch4) # pacman -Syy5) pacman -Ss networkmanagerexpected result: Step 2: maximum 1 day lag between Parabola repos and upstream repos, all upstream updates except blacklisted ones are available in Parabola Step 5: extra/networkmanager 1.40.12-1 (or newer) is in the output since it was updated upstream on 2023-01-26actual result: Step 2: it looks like Parabola repos stopped syncing correctly since 2023-01-27, because no updated packages are visible since then, while upstream has dozens (hundreds?) at the same time. Step 5: extra/networkmanager 1.40.10-1 is in the output
