dino was not broken - it could not be installed today; but anyone who had it installed already could use it - the same is true for gajim-plugin-omemo - probably gajim-plugin-omemo only needs to be rebuilt - dino needed gst-plugins-bad to be rebuilt; and it was quite painful this time

these conflicts happen because "rolling distro" - there is nothing wrong or broken - this is the package manager doing its job, by preventing conflicting packages from being installed or upgraded, which would break things otherwise
