With their blessing and support, we then obtained the original source code for Beneath a Steel Sky and added support for it to our adventure game interpreter, ScummVM. And now, on the eve of ScummVM 0.5.0 (the first release featuring B.A.S.S support), Revolution Software Ltd. has decided to release Sky to the public as freeware!

So that is probably OK FSDG wise as this data could be considered as non-functionnal and that we get permissions to redisrtibute it even commercially.

However AFAIK Parabola has a free culture requirement, so even if we have the right to modify it, we might lack the information to do that (the source code).

Though maybe some people have more information about the game format and all, so maybe I'm mistaken?
