Not sure if this a related issue to https://labs.parabola.nu/issues/3497			
It seems some pacakge have not received the update from upstream archarm after the 28th June, despite packages being updated there after this date and the relevant package for x86_64 updating in parabola repos in the same time period.			
For example. Dino:			
Upstream it was updated on the 29th June, https://archlinuxarm.org/packages/armv7h/dino with 0.4.2.3			
however for the corresponding package in parabola extra <u>https://www.parabola.nu/packages/extra/armv7h/dino/</u> is not updated and is still 0.4.2.2 whilst extra x86_64 shows as updated 0.4.2.3 updated shortly after its upstream as expected.			
pacman -Syu shows no update either for this and others and pacman -Ss dino shows the older version. The last package updates for armv7h where on the 28th June in parabola, but as mentioned above others like this one have had an update since upstream.			
Just thought i'd mention the issue, incase its a similar issue to this https://labs.parabola.nu/issues/3497 and something got clogged.
