<p>When uncommenting some vars like PKGDEST or SRCDEST and leaving the defaults, I would expect that directories were created and that they contains the expected files. However, they appears as files. For example, try building your-freedom creates a /home/sources wich is a copy of blacklist*.txt file, and building widelands /home/packages becomes a binary file and /home/sources the launcher of the binary (a sh script).</p> <p>I though that maybe the script is doing `cp file \$SRCDEST` before assuring \$SRCDEST (or other) is an existing directory.</p> <p>I attach my libretools.conf and makepkg.conf.</p>
