<b>Description</b> Mailman puts all notification emails sent to the dev list in its moderation queue with the reason "Message has implicit destination". Disabling "Blind carbon copy recipients (bcc)" solves this, but it leaks emails of all subscribers in the mail sent to the list. Is it ok? Can it be fixed to send a separate mail with the user in the To header? Or is it a mail server issue?
