### [systemd] version 225 is still in the Repositories

<b>Description</b> Although systemd 226 is released and all its dependencies are in the repositories, the package systemd is still version 225 in [libre] repository. I managed to upgrade to 226, downloading libsystemd-226-1-x86_64.pkg.tar.xz from Parabola homepage and install it manually with Pacman -U. Systemd226 is needed to handle dbus <a href="https://www.archlinux.org/news/d-bus-now-launches-user-buses/">https://www.archlinux.org/news/d-bus-now-launches-user-buses/</a> (in my case routing pulseaudio through jack sound server). When i make however pacman -Syu, it says that my systemd is local and newer than [libre]
