The issue occurred since the update the other day to version 1:41.0.2.deb1-1 On Gnome the icon in the panel is not displayed correctly (just the bottom left corner of it) No icon is shown next to Activities button as well. The icon however is shown correctly when "Show applications" button is pressed (meta search) My guess is that some of the icon resolutions have gone missing. PC: The big drinking occasion is that gnome-web (epiphany) is working better than ever before. Its not related just worth mentioning loudly :-D
