When trying to run Seeks in a terminal, "seeks: error while loading shared libraries: libcui18n.so.48: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory". My architecture is i686. I can't figure out what these shared libraries are, and I have no idea how I broke Seeks, which was running fine for days if not weeks.
