Failed to open VDPAU backend libvdpau_va_gl.so: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory			
I have the latest packages, and I noticed there have been recent updates to vlc, mediastreamer, xine-lib, ffmpeg and libx264 to name a few that might be relevant.

Instead, the video became very jerky (VLC started probably using it for hardware acceleration but it doesn't work on my computer, I suppose). I tried different audio devices etc on VLC with no luck yet. This is most probably related to some package upgrade because I've had no problems previously. Maybe I'll need to downgrade a bunch of packages and see if it has an effect.
